#### **TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990**

#### THE STOPPING UP OF HIGHWAYS (EAST) (NO.28) ORDER 2023

The Secretary of State makes this Order in exercise of powers under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act").

- The Secretary of State authorises the stopping up of the highways described in the 1. Schedule to this Order and shown on site plans 2 to 5, numbered NATTRAN/E/S247/5515, to enable development to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted by South Cambridgeshire District Council, under reference 22/03615/REM.
- 2. The developer shall to the reasonable satisfaction of Cambridgeshire County (1) Council, as local highway authority, provide: -
  - (a) new highway as proposed and detailed in the approved planning permission, development plans and associated legal agreements with the Council and shown on site plans 1 to 5; and
  - improvement of the highway as proposed and detailed in the approved planning permission, development plans and associated legal agreements with the Council and shown on site plans 1 to 5.
- Where immediately before the date of this Order there is any apparatus of statutory 3. undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across any highway authorised to be stopped up pursuant to this Order then, subject to section 261(4) of the Act, those undertakers shall have the same rights as respects that apparatus after that highway is stopped up as they had immediately beforehand.

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#### THE SCHEDULE

#### Description of highways to be stopped up

The highways to be stopped up are at Hinxton in the District of South Cambridgeshire, shown on the plan as: -

- 1. An irregular shaped western part width of Cambridge Road (A1301). It commences from grid reference E: 549872, N: 245023 extending in a south easterly direction for a distance of 494.6 metres when measured along its western boundary and having a maximum width of 21.9 metres (marked 1 on site plan 2, 3 and 4).
- 2. An irregular shaped eastern part width of Cambridge Road (A1301). It commences from

- grid reference E: 549968, N: 244849 extending in a south easterly direction for a distance of 133.7 metres and having a maximum width of 6.8 metres (marked 2 on site plan 3).
- 3. An irregular shaped eastern part width of Cambridge Road (A1301). It commences from grid reference E: 550061, N: 244672 extending in a south easterly direction for a distance of 65.7 metres and having a maximum width of 3.2 metres (marked 3 on site plan 4).
- 4. An irregular shaped eastern part width of Cambridge Road (A1301). It commences from grid reference E: 550122, N: 244545 extending in a south easterly direction for a distance of 8.8 metres and having a maximum width of 0.4 metres (marked 4 on site plan 4).
- 5. An irregular shaped eastern part width of Cambridge Road (A1301). It commences from grid reference E: 550134, N: 244496 extending in a south easterly direction for a distance of 49.2 metres and having a maximum width of 2.5 metres (marked 5 on site plan 4 and 5).
- 6. An irregular shaped eastern part width of Cambridge Road (A1301). It commences from grid reference E: 550190, N: 244403 extending in a south easterly direction for a distance of 9.7 metres and having a maximum width of 0.8 metres (marked 6 on site plan 4 and 5).
