It was agreed to look at getting a list of priorities which are urgent and which could be done now.</li> <li>Cars stuck in flooded Ford recently- any update from Highways as to the process that is in place for shutting the gates? Reply from Highways: Order to close gates is issued by the Flood Warning Duty Officer who, when the triggers have been met, will call Cambridgeshire Highways to inform them that water is on the road, they should then go out and close the road. The triggers measures we use are: Great Chesterford gauge at 0.28mac, with the remove being Great Chesterford gauge at 0.26mac Please take into account that the gauge is upstream of the road and so lead time is built into these triggers.
